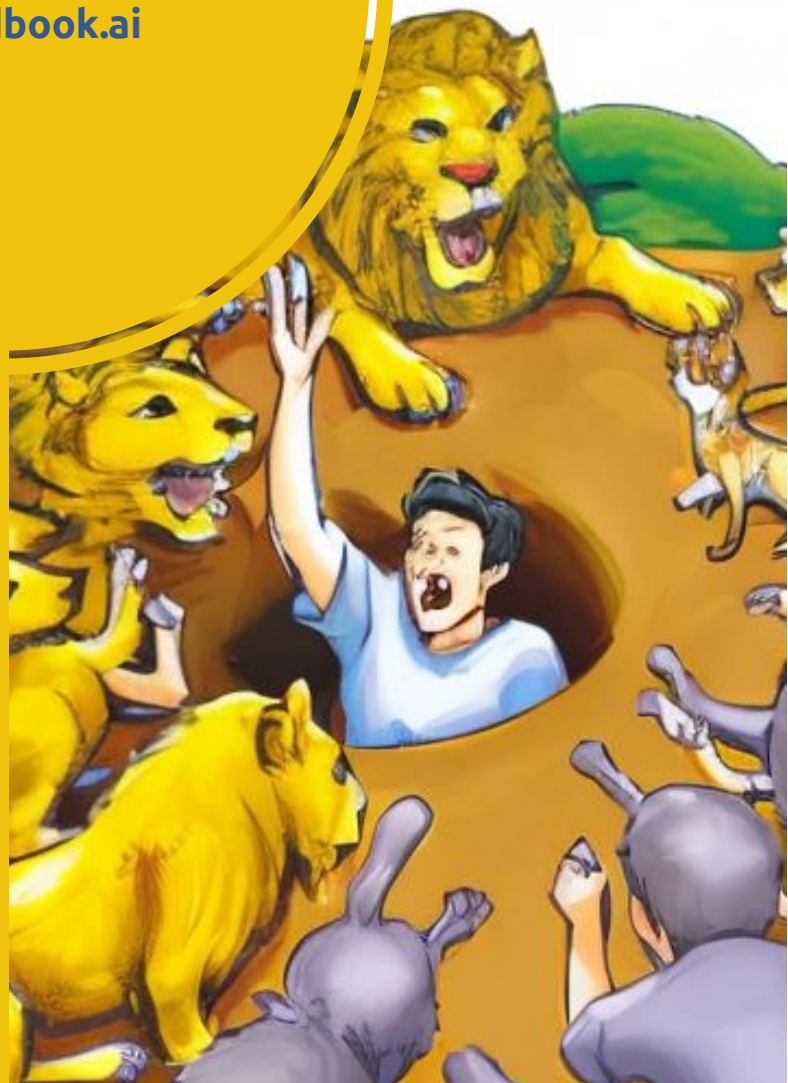




DANIEL IN THE LION'S DEN

The king was upset that Daniel had broken the law and ordered him to be thrown into a den of hungry lions. Daniel was scared, but he knew that God was with him.



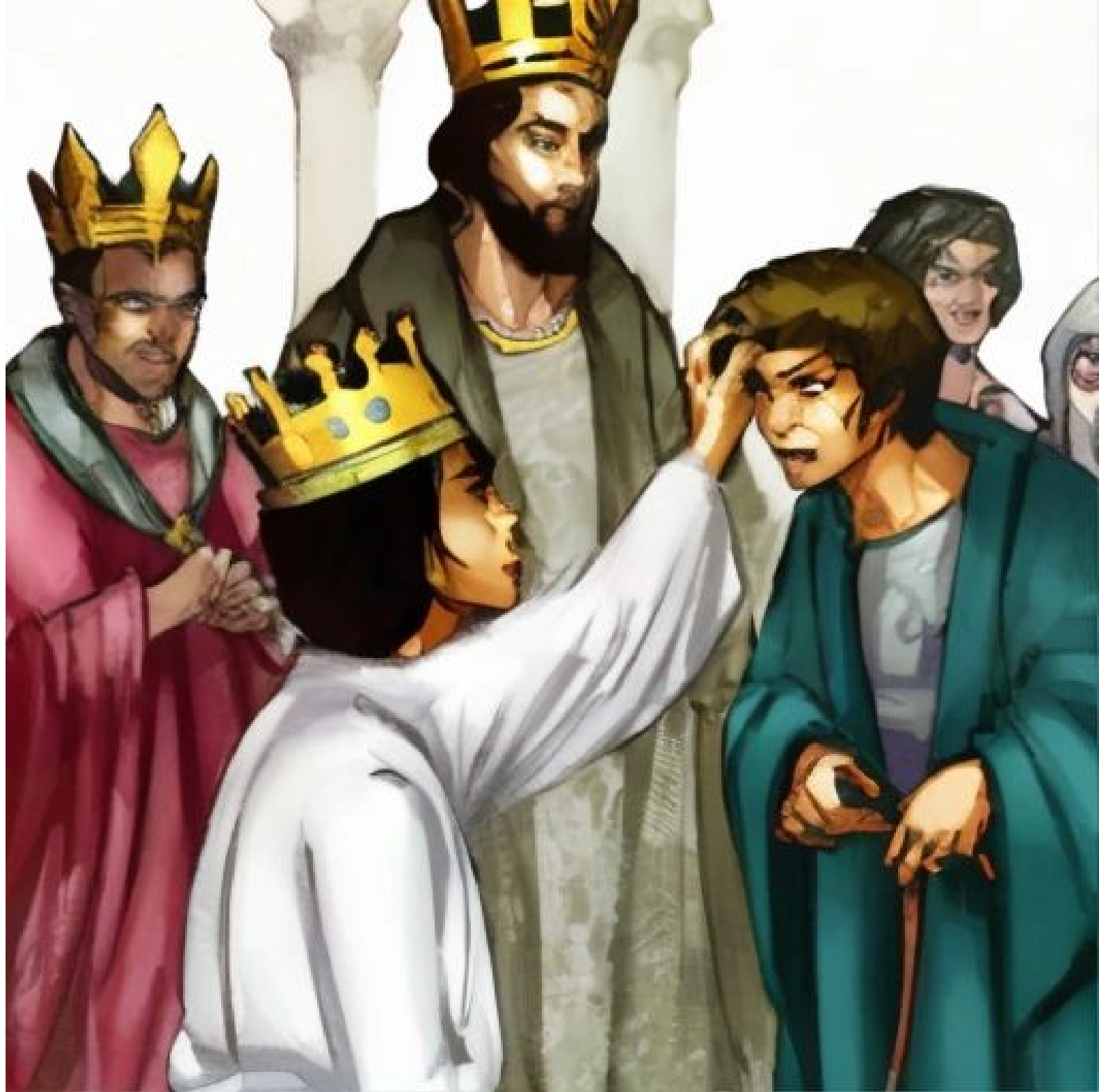
