castle, from the grand hall to the secret passages.



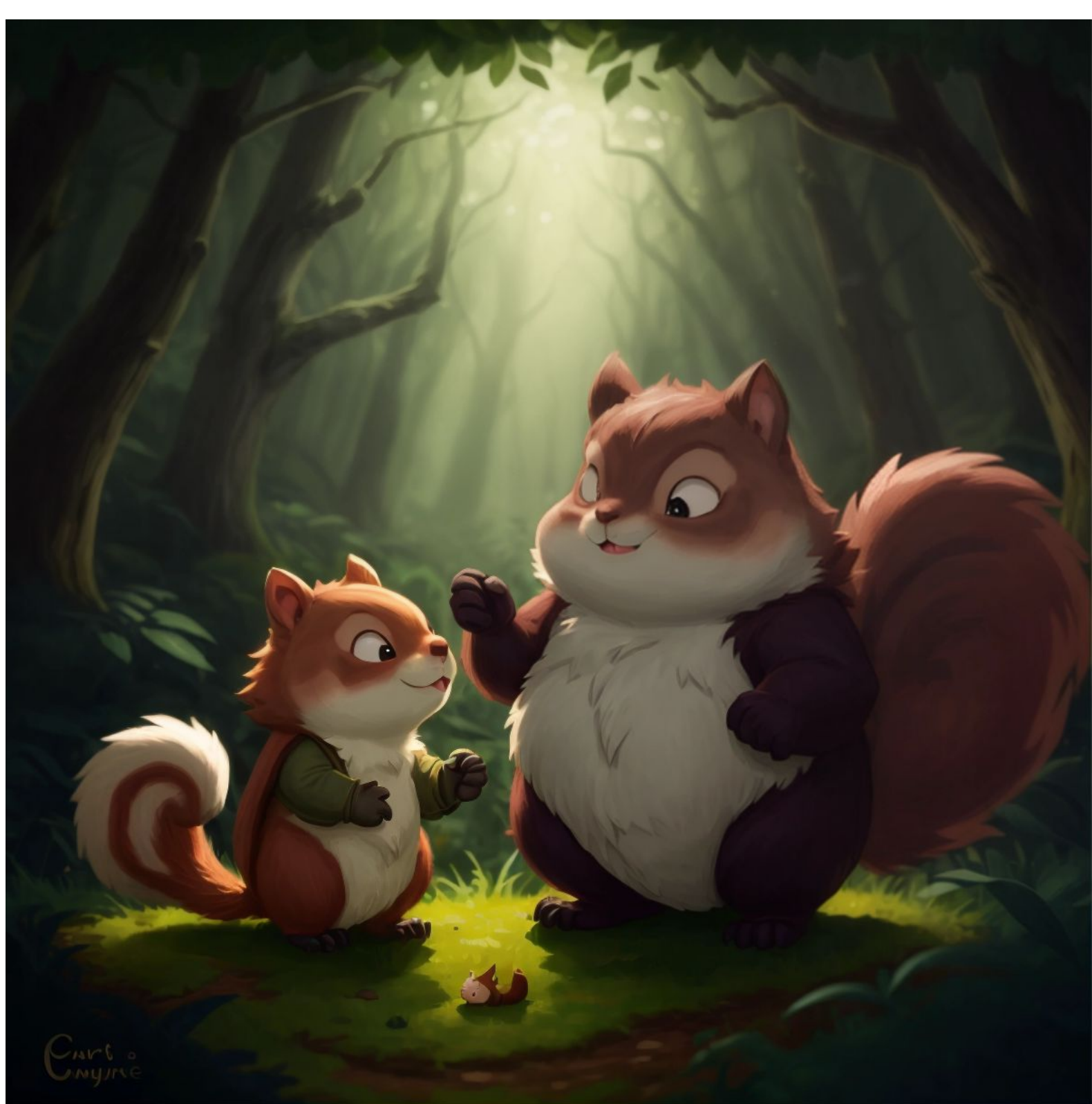
