



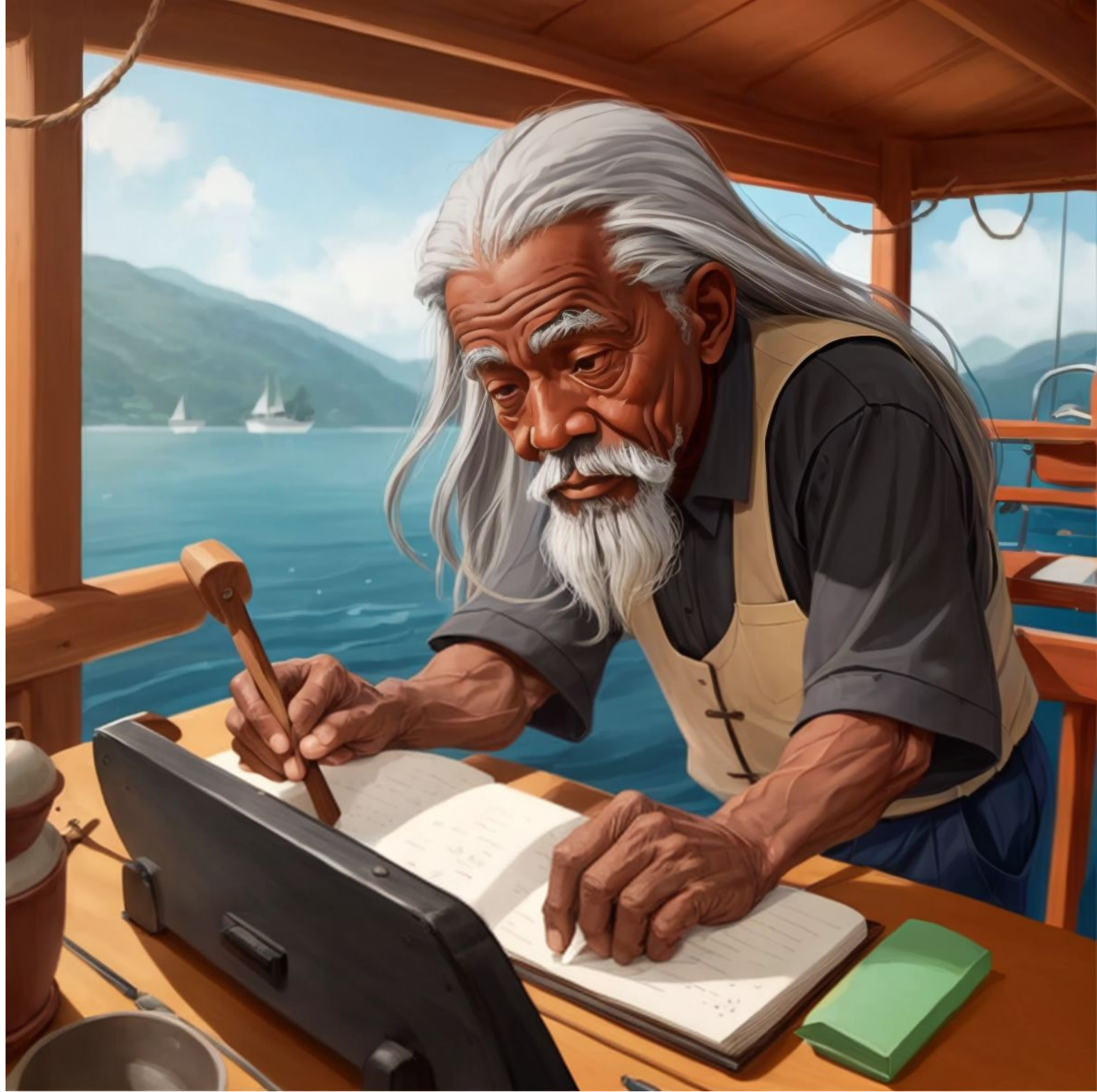
NOAH AND THE BIG BOAT
