embark on an adventure to find the forgotten castle.



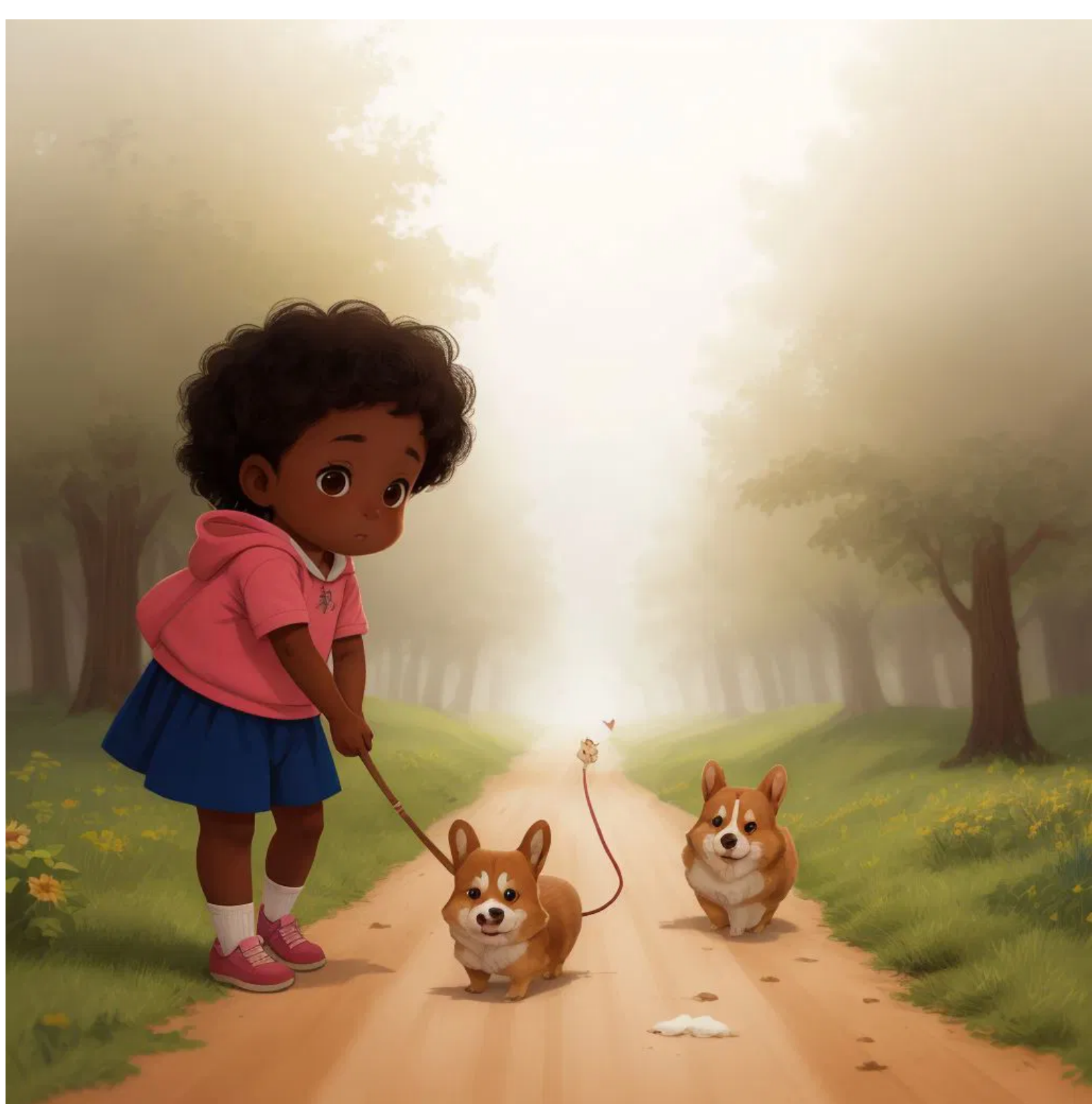

wings in delight. 'Well done, brave travelers,' it said, allowing them passage. The Royal Corgi barked joyfully, leading them across.



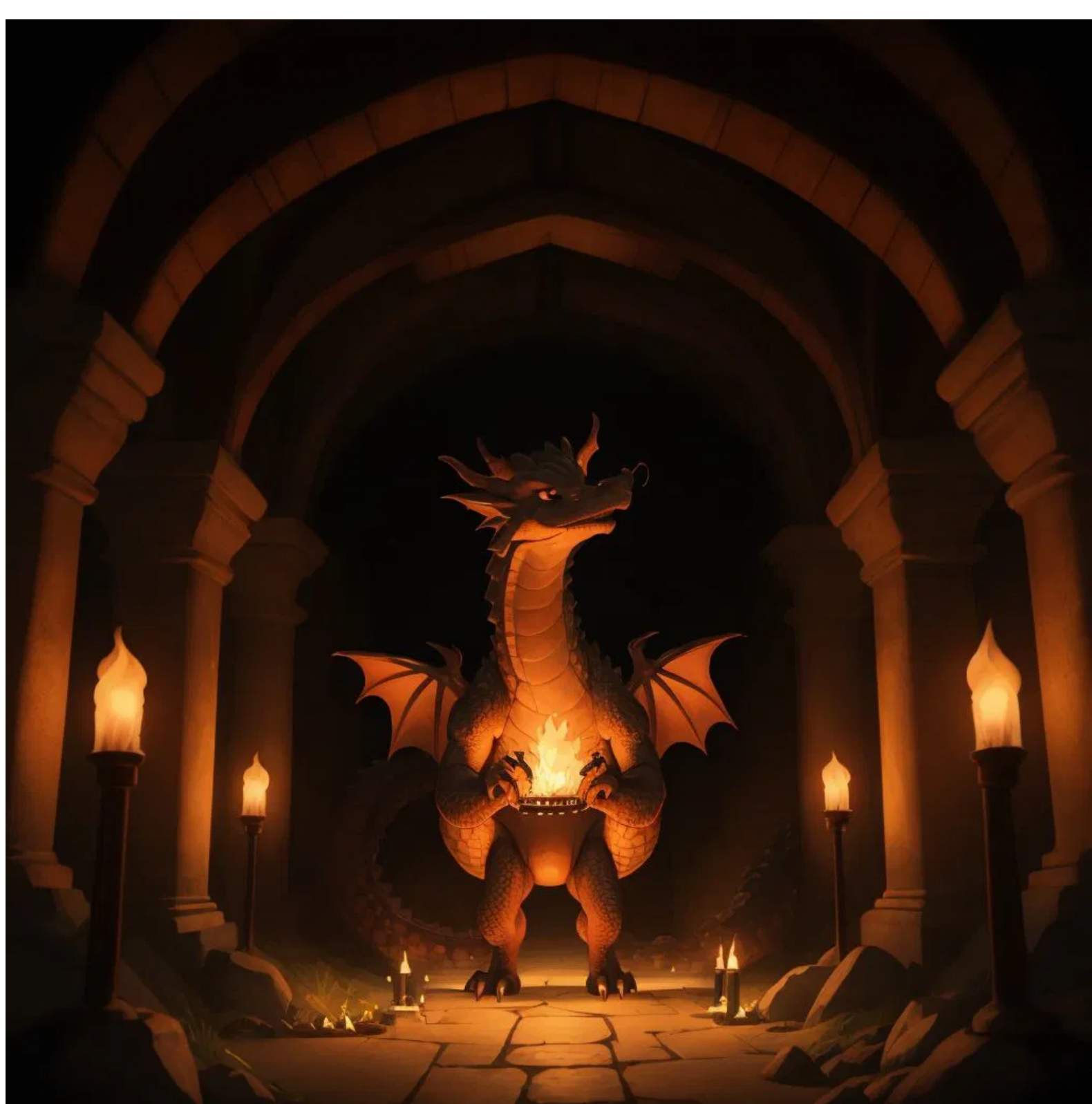
